The country is reeling in the wake of the *Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health Organization* decision, which overtuned *Roe v. Wade* and *Planned Parenthood of Southeastern Pa. v. Casey*, leaving women's rights to bodily autonomy and reproductive freedom to the whims of state politicians, and eviscerating women's right to equal protection, bring women's rights back to the 1850s.

Federal elected officials are scrambling to try to address the issue. They continue to call upon President Biden to take bold action. However, most have yet to demand publication of the Equal Rights Amendment ("ERA") even though they know that publication of the ERA will save *Roe v. Wade* and guarantee equality for all.

While we continue our discussions and meetings with the White House and U.S. Senators and Representatives, there is an additional group we are targeting – certain pro-choice, pro-equality Governors – to help us continue to put pressure on the Biden/Harris Administration to publish the ERA as required by law.

As a result of the Dobbs decision, women's reproductive rights will be determined by the states and, therefore, will differ based on where they live. Twenty-six states will, in all likelihood, have a total ban in the very near future, including Kentucky, Michigan, and Wisconsin. The burden of this crisis weighs heavily on these Governors.

Women fortunate enough to travel will go to abortion-friendly states, such as California, New York, Illinois, New Jersey, Washington, New Mexico, Colorado, Maryland, and North Carolina, to seek reproductive healthcare. As a result, the abortion clinics in those states will be overwhelmed, and residents from such states will have to wait longer for care. For those unable to travel, the results may be far more tragic.

There is a huge grassroots effort as well as political pressure being placed on the Biden/Harris Administration!

Women fortunate enough to travel will go to abortion-friendly states, such as North Carolina, California, New York, Illinois, New Jersey, Maryland, Washington, New Mexico, and Colorado, to seek reproductive healthcare. As a result, the abortion clinics in those states will be overwhelmed, and residents from such states will have to wait longer for care. For those unable to travel, the results may be far more tragic.

However, there is a federal solution that will ensure all women and girls, regardless of where they live, can access reproductive healthcare and, at the same time, guarantee equality for all – publication of the federal Equal Rights Amendment ("ERA"). The ERA guarantees equal protection based on sex, a right the Supreme Court indicated in Dobbs women no longer have.



As determined by hundreds of constitutional scholars, the ERA became the 28th Amendment to the Constitution on January 27, 2020, the date Virginia became the 38th state to ratify the ERA.
